### Super Views

Summer is finally here, and with it has brought high temperatures and no rain to date. However, all three courses are transitioning very well this year. This means we will have an excellent bermudagrass base in which to overseed into this fall. The Hill greens have fully transitioned away from the overseeded turf back into their mini-verde Bermuda base. Aside from preparing the courses for summer transition, our team has been working on a few summer projects to improve our property. They include:

- Renovating both practice greens at the driving range along with expanding and re-shaping both practice bunkers. Both greens have now been restored to their original size. Both greens are mild in shape to allow for a consistent read of speed in putting. Both greens have now been converted to mini-verde variety bermudagrass just like the Hill course.
- Adding irrigation to the front portion of Canyon 5 green complex to ensure consistent turf in front of the greenside bunker.
- Moving irrigation heads away from Hill greens. This will allow for better water distribution as well as less interference on putts or short chips around those greens. We believe these changes will allow for more consistency in turf health as well as a better practice facility to help improve your game.

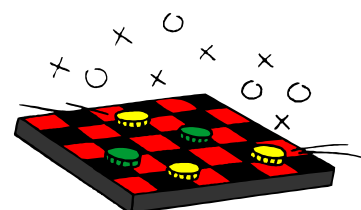

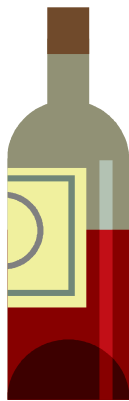

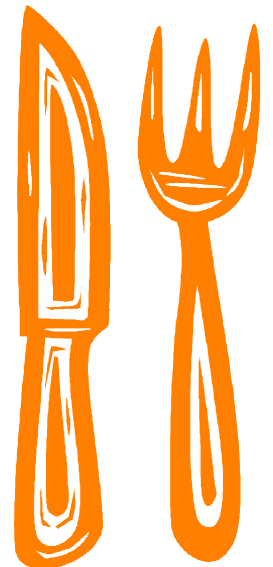
